HOW TO APPLY

Applications containing the name, university, email address, discipline and transcript (showing some courses relevant to the topic), and a motivation letter (1 page) should be sent via email to Dr. Claudia Matthes (Claudia.matthes@sowi.hu-berlin.de) by 19 February 2018.

The cover letter should explain how the participation in the seminar would potentially improve the applicant's knowledge on the issue and what he/she expects to gain during the workshop/site visit.

DEADLINE NOON 19 FEBRUARY 2018

The participation fee for the seminar will amount up to 200 €. Travel and accommodation costs will be reimbursed.
